The Macintosh Computer Learning Center, maintained and staffed by volunteer members of the Leisure World Macintosh Users Group, continues to offer all visitors guidance and instruction on things Apple and Macintosh.

The Center is open five days every week, Monday through Friday, with the exception of Holiday dates, from 9 in the morning to 3 in the afternoon. Various educational Classes, which are presented in the afternoon hours, occasionally will take priority over regular open hours.

However, the fact remains that every week our Club offers about 30 hours of opportunity for you, the Mac computer user, to come in and speak to the Supervisor about your Mac problems.

You can be a beginner, a new user, an intermediate, or advanced Mac user, or even a PC user, and ask your question(s). Although all Supervisors are experienced Mac users he/she may not be able to answer your particular question. In such a case, the Super will usually suggest you speak to another experienced Club member who may have some background in the area of your interest.

So, you will get either an immediate answer or the referral to someone that could have the answer. And this is the purpose for having a Learning Center. Although we hope our visitors are MUG members, the doors are open to welcome all Leisure World residents and their guests.

In the many years I have been associated with the Club, and the Learning Center, it has always been a mystery to me why more members, and other folks, do not take advantage of the learning opportunities available through this one-on-one tutoring system. A Super will come sit by your side and give you guidance and instruction on subjects important to you. There is no cost or obligation.
